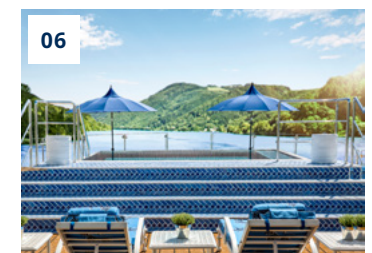

Over the last couple of years, we've piloted a comprehensive food waste measurement and reduction system known as **Leanpath** on a select few ships. In 2022 alone, food waste was reduced by 34% across 6 Uniworld ships, equating to 24,169 meals saved. In 2023, we expanded the program to every ship we own!

We're eliminating single-use plastics across our fleet by introducing refillable toiletry dispensers, bamboo room keys, cloth laundry bags, and more.
